It might be asking your learner to read a sign at the supermarket, spell a 'heart word' in the car while you're on the go, or complete a short online activity from the website.

These small, consistent opportunities all add up to help build confidence, reinforce skills, and make learning feel natural rather than overwhelming.

As always, remember that perfection is never the goal. Instead, we focus on consistent practice, because it's practice that makes things '*permanent*'.

This term, one of my young learners reshaped this idea in a way that felt right for her. With just one small, personalised tweak, the message became something entirely new; something meaningful, motivating, and hers.

It was a beautiful reminder that when learners connect with an idea, they own it.

Perhaps her version might resonate with you or your child too.

Because in the end, it's the small, steady efforts that truly make a difference.
